The works comprised of:

- The demolition of the existing precast concrete columns and roof structures in the West Ambulatory and the installation of a replacement glass roof with steelwork support structure.
- The installation of a new ramped floor with stone finish to new profile; new timber panelling to west elevation; new lighting and other sundry associated works.

Being the oldest stone building within London, all works were undertaken under the watchful eye of English Heritage.
